Contest & Exhibit Guidelines:

The contest is open to *amateur* artists from Holmes County and the greater Holmes County area (within approximately two (2) miles of the Holmes County line), and there is no entry fee. The artist must have completed the work when he/she was at least 55 years old. Up to three entries may be submitted per artist, and one entry form should be completed for each entry. The final determination of the category for each piece will be at the discretion of the Art Show Committee. Each entry is eligible to win in one category only. Artwork that was entered in a previous year’s contest may be re-entered if the piece has not won a First or Second Place award. Visitors to the Exhibit will vote for the People’s Choice. Except for the People’s Choice Award, winners will be announced at the Meet the Artist Reception on Friday, August 25 from 6 to 8 p.m. The Exhibit will be open to the public on Saturday, August 26, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

All entry forms must be submitted by August 11, 2017. Artwork should be brought to the Walnut Hills Retirement Home, located at 4770 Olde Pump Street in Walnut Creek, on August 23, 2017, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Please do not bring your artwork before August 23 as storage space is limited at the Retirement Home.
